Our August speaker will be our new member, Pat of Monarch Fabrics in Long Beach. She is going to be showing us some examples of scrap and fat quarter quilts and will give hints on choosing coordinating fabrics for our quilts. She will have some quilt books available for purchase at a discount.

We will also be having a fat quarter drawing. Our theme will be bright summer fabrics. For every fat quarter you bring, you will receive one ticket for the drawing. The fat quarters will be bundled in coordinating (we hope) bundles of 6 fat quarters. Tickets will be drawn, and each winner will receive 6 fat quarters. Don't know how to cut a fat quarter? Just start with a half yard of fabric, and then cut it down the center fold line to make 2 fat quarters, approximately 18" x 22", depending on the width of the fabric. No need to cut the selvage off, just make sure to cut an even rectangle.
