Theme- Scavenger Hunt (Begins in December 2016)

Due Date: March 2, 2017 at the **beginning of the Guild meeting**

The challenge is to incorporate as many as possible of the items listed below into your quilt. How you accomplish that is open to: block choices, applique, quilting, embellishment and your imagination.

Quilt must be no larger than 36 inches in each direction. Quilt may be oval, hexagon, circle, etc. but no larger than 36".

Entry is to be a small quilt or wall hanging. Please no tote bags, pocket books, vests, jackets, etc.

Entry may be machine or hand pieced.

Entry must be machine or hand quilted solely by the participant. Long arm quilting is acceptable but it must be completed by the participant.

Label must be attached to the back side of the quilt. Please include with your name, **the number of items you incorporated** into your project (no need to list them). (ie: Made by Donna McDaniel. There are 29 items on my quilt)

Only finished entries will be accepted.

All participants will receive a gift for their completed entry. Each participant will be entered into an opportunity raffle to be awarded at the end of the event.

Ribbons will be given for top winners in various categories.
