

Our other choice is to participate in a paper-pieced project to make a quilt for next year's tea. I have permission from the designer to use her paper pieced coffee and tea cups, which have many ways to enhance them. We will have a free workshop if needed to teach paper-piecing for those interested. Contact me to get on the interest list.

The tea quilt will feature 4 different cup designs and at least one teapot. The only color requirement for these blocks is that the background must be a fabric with a white background with tiny flowers and/or leaves of a color that will complement the cup. They will be sashed once we have enough cups with a sashing to be decided upon later.

You may get creative with the cups. Seasonal fabrics, fussy-cut flowers, animals, sports, etc. We hope to have enough variety to make the quilt interesting to buyers. The papers for piecing will be available at the July meeting.
