

# Memorial Flower Block

Acacia Quilt Guild of O.C.

Blocks may be any floral color fabric that reads as solid. Background is green that resembles foliage. Center is black, yellow or orange



For each flower you will need the following fabric:

4 4 1/2 " Squares (flower)

8 2 " Green squares (background)

1 2 1/2" circle (center)

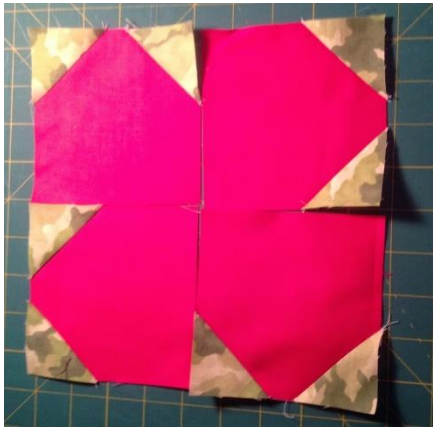
Double sided fusible interfacing to attach



Draw diagonal line corner to corner on back of green blocks

Pin and sew on line on 2 sides of petal square as shown

Cut  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from stitching then press flat and square up to  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " if necessary



Arrange like petals as shown and stitch together checking orientation with photo

Square up to  $8\frac{1}{2}$ "



Press petal seams open and add center of flower

Use black, yellow or orange for center Attach with double sided interfacing, satin or buttonhole stitch, or you may use needle turn applique

This quilt (or quilts) will be assembled as a garden of flowers

of various colors in memory of those who lost their lives in the COVID 19 pandemic

This pattern was originally offered free on Etsy several years ago by unknown designer
