#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Our June meeting is our 9th annual potluck as we celebrate the completion of 9 years of existence as a guild. Bring anything you want, except that we will provide cake for dessert. As a special event, we will have a demonstration of self defense for women by Gianna Williams of "Damsel in Defense." You will also have the opportunity to purchase items to keep yourself safe from attack. Gianna will be giving us some of these items for door prizes too!

Be sure to bring your 20 10" squares of batik fabric if you want to participate in our batik exchange. These squares can be all one color or more than one color if you are cutting from your stash. If purchasing fabric, please buy 1 1/2 yards to cut.

These fabrics do not need to be prewashed, as the process of making commercial batik fabric preshrinks and sets the color on the fabric. Please cut accurately, and if you have trouble cutting accurately, cut generously.

Please fold each piece of the fabric in half, then criss-cross and put in a zip lock bag with your name on it. You may trade more than one set of 20, if you want to make the larger quilt, but put each set in separate bags.

Remember, we are offering a free workshop on Saturday, June 8 where we will be making Lyn Brown's pattern "Slow Turning". This is free for anyone who helped in any way with the Tea and Auction, **and** for new members who joined in May or June.

I would like this last opportunity to thank all those who helped this be a successful year.

#### INTERNATIONAL QUILT FESTIVAL VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

Quilters,

International Quilt Festival/Long Beach, CA will be August 2nd -4th, 2013 with preview day on the 1st, at the Long Beach Convention Center.

We are looking for workers to help hang the special exhibit quilts before the Festival, guardians to watch over the quilts during the Festival, doorpersons to take tickets, and workers to help with takedown of special exhibit quilts after the show is closed. There are paid positions of \$8 an hour plus free parking and you receive free entry for each day you work.

Even if you are a guardian or a door guard you can (on your off time) walk around and look closely at the quilts. Some of the doorpersons are sitting positions, but most are standing or you can work to hang the quilts (hanger position). If you have questions you can call Susan Stokes or Phyllis Campbell as we have worked the show for the last 3 years. Or you can call Terri (her number is at the bottom of this page).
