Draw lines to split shapes in half or make new shapes.

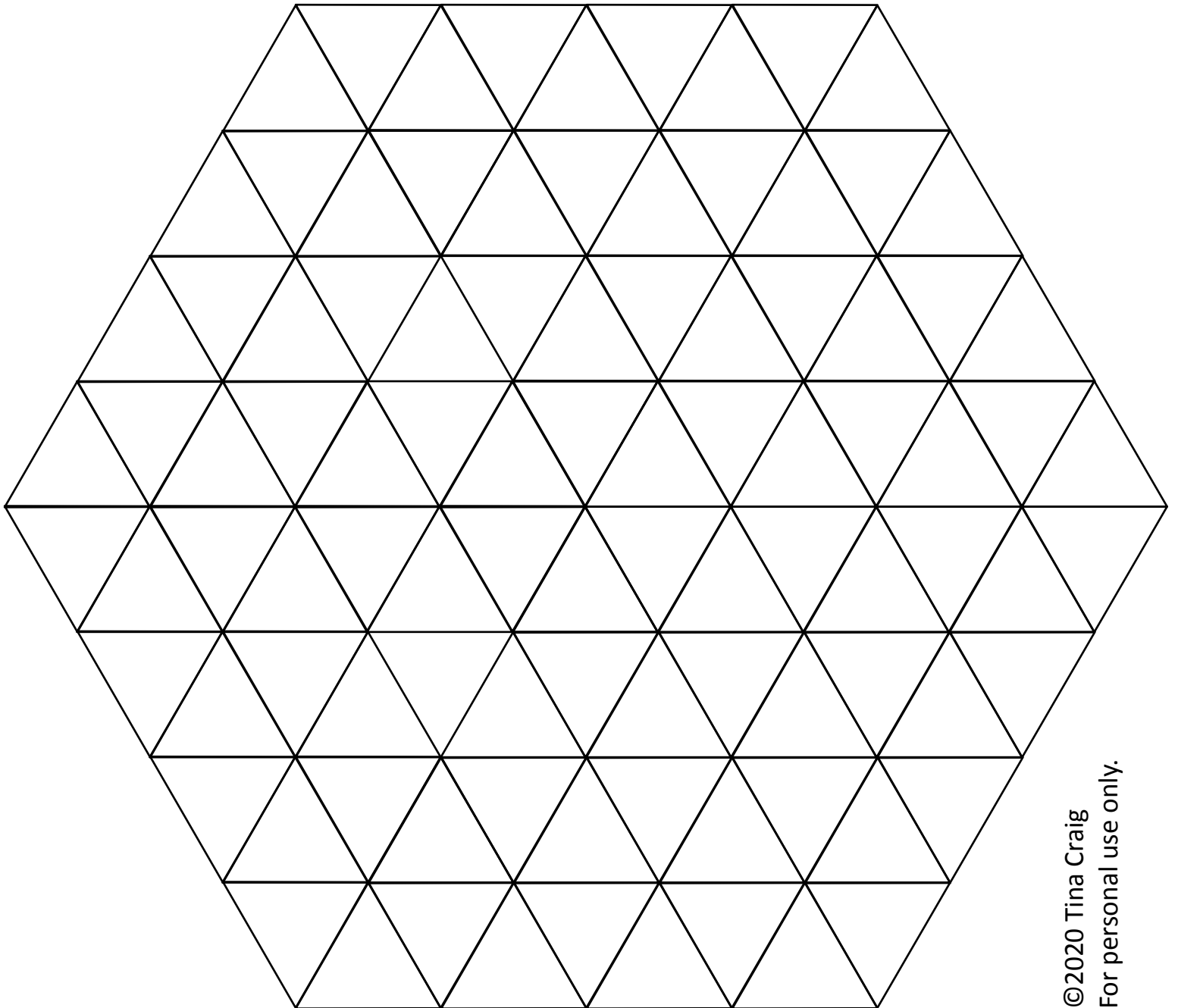
Color in your design with colored pencils or crayons.

Label shapes as needed.

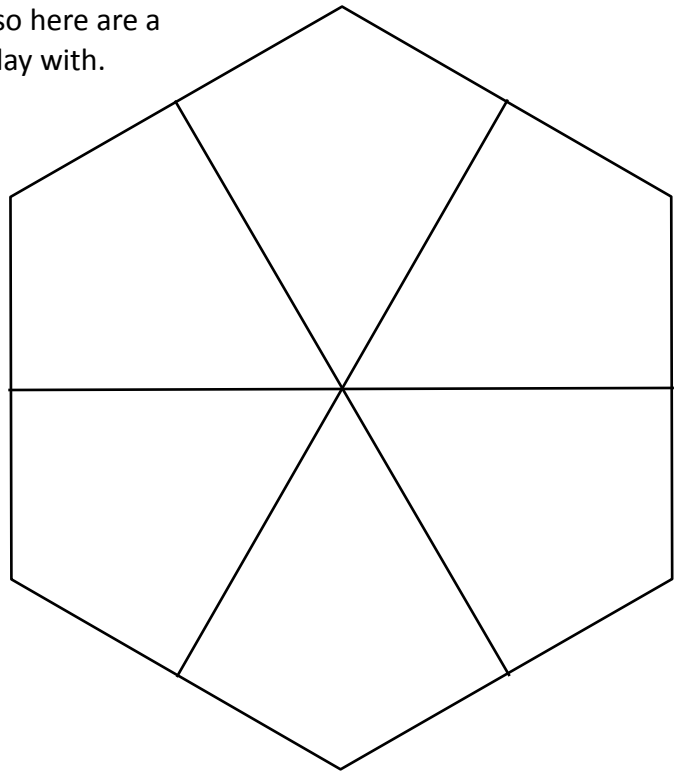
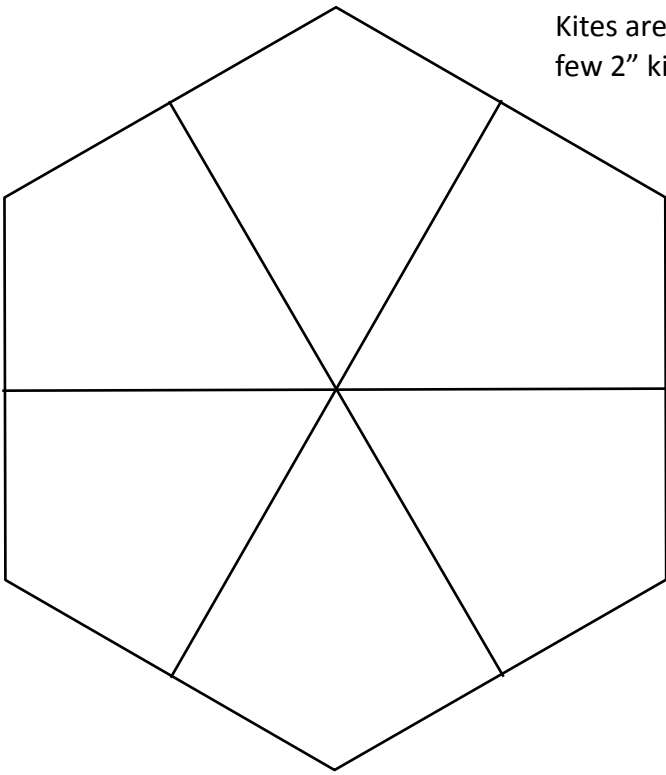
Consider fussy cutting for added interest.
